

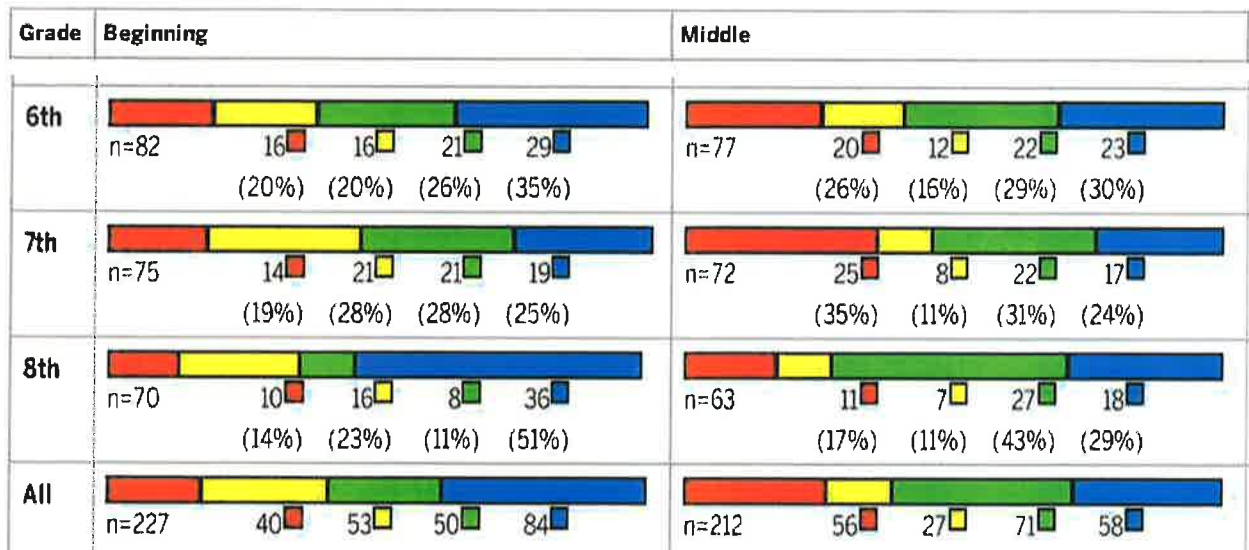
## Pleasant Hill Middle School 2024-2025 School Year 1st Semester Academic Report

For Semester 1 final grades we had 29 6th and 7th graders, failing at least one class, with a total of 58 total F's. 8 6th graders, with a total of 16 F's and 21 7th graders with a total of 42 F's.

Total F's are up 18%, while 6th F's are up 32% while the number of students failing one or more class doubled from the 1st quarter to end of the semester. 7th grade F's are up 12% while the number of 7th graders failing one or more class is up 3 students.

6th grade students having negligible risk decreased by 5%, students with minimal risk increased 3%, students needing strategic support decreased by 4% and students needing intensive support increased by 6%.

7th grade students having negligible risk decreased by 1%, students with minimal risk increased 3%, students needing strategic support decreased by 12% and students needing intensive support increased by 16%.

8th grade students having negligible risk decreased by 22%, students with minimal risk increased 32%, students needing strategic support decreased by 12% and students needing intensive support increased by 3%.
