1. RESOLVED, that the Board of Education approves the Superintendent's recommendation to approve the collective bargaining agreement between the District and the United Public Service Employees Union ("UPSEU"), representing the Custodial Unit of employees at the Hempstead Public Schools, for a five-year contract term, from July 1, 2012 through and inclusive of June 30, 2017, approved and ratified by the UPSEU on May 12, 2015, and recognizes, with great appreciation and satisfaction, that the District and the UPSEU came to an agreement, not only on wages, but also on performance evaluations, time keeping, and other terms.

Trustee Touré moved, seconded by Trustee Cooke to approve a settlement agreement between the district and the employee named within the resolution

2. WHEREAS, the Board of Education ("Board") of the Hempstead Union Free School District ("District") has concluded that it is in the best interests of the District to resolve the grievance of former Hempstead Middle School Teacher, Marie Cimaglia ("Cimaglia") in lieu of a resolution by an arbitrator; and

WHEREAS, the Board has considered the merits of the grievance and the likelihood of prevailing after an arbitration hearing; and

WHEREAS, the District endeavors to achieve an ultimate cost savings in legal fees and arbitration fees and to avoid a potential adverse judgment after arbitration; and

WHEREAS, the District endeavors to avoid a binding precedent adverse to the District's interests with respect to the interpretation and implementation of the collective bargaining agreement with the Hempstead Classroom Teachers' Association; and

WHEREAS, the attorneys for the District, with the input and guidance of the Board President, Lamont Johnson, and the Superintendent of Schools, Susan Johnson, have negotiated a Settlement Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Board has considered the terms of the negotiated Settlement Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Board believes the negotiated Settlement Agreement to be in the best interests of the District; be it

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RESOLVED, that the Board of Education approves the Settlement Agreement, resolving the Cimaglia grievance; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Board authorizes the Board President to execute the Settlement Agreement on behalf of the District; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Board directs the Superintendent to accept Cimaglia's resignation in lieu of her termination; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Board directs the Associate Superintendent for Human Resources to remove and expunge from Cimaglia's personnel file, any documents referring to her termination, subject to the limitations set forth in the Settlement Agreement; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Board directs the Assistant Superintendent for Business and Operations to remit payment to Cimaglia, in the amount of \$20,000.00, as full and fair consideration in exchange for the withdrawal of her grievance, during the first payroll period following the Board's approval of this Resolution.
