As for the state comptroller's audit, the findings were as shocking to me as they were to you all .as board member the law requires us to act based upon information, recommendations and guidance provided by the paid professionals. They are required to make legally sound fiscally responsible recommendations. You have not offered on positive remedy for the many ills you so eagerly,

dramatically and strategically point out to the press. What do you really want? You have two people on the Board that you worked tirelessly to elect. Why didn't you come to us to work with us before taking this vaudeville act on the road? I don't believe that you have any true interest in addressing the needs of the children or the community. You pleasure is in making inflammatory statements to the press without offering any resolution or resolve. Shame on you all. Let us as a people organize and educate ourselves the acquire the skills necessary to address these complex issues that affect our community.
