# Trustee Johnson moved, seconded by Trustee Simmons to approve the kindergarten transportation resolution as indicated.

**RESOLVED**, that the Board of Education (the "Board") of the Hempstead Union Free School District (the "District"), effective September 2, 2014 and thereafter, will provide bus transportation to students attending Prospect School at the beginning and end of the school day, at a cost in the 2014-15 school year budget not to exceed EIGHT

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HUNDRED THOUSAND and 00/100 DOLLARS (\$800,000.00) for the 2014-2015 school year, on an emergency basis; and it is

**FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Board considers bus transportation for its Kindergarten students attending Prospect School to be a high priority to protect the health, safety and welfare of its youngest students, and is authorizing and directing the Superintendent to implement this "Kindergarten Transportation Program" in a manner that addresses the critical safety concern that over four hundred (400) kindergarten students attending Prospect School enter and exit at virtually the same time each day, adjacent to a very busy roadway, namely, Peninsula Boulevard, which time coincides with heavy commuter traffic on a vital roadway to the economy of the Village of Hempstead. The combination of heavy vehicular traffic on Peninsula Boulevard, and at the same time, heavy pedestrian traffic involving Kindergarten students attending Prospect School, increases the risk of accidents occurring that could cause serious injury to the District's youngest students at the start and end of the school day at Prospect School. Accordingly, the District will implement this "Kindergarten Transportation Program" immediately; and it is

**FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Superintendent of Schools will establish regulations by which the "Kindergarten Transportation Program" is implemented to both: (1) ensure safe and efficient ingress and egress to/from the Prospect School by the children at the start and end of the school day; and (2) avoid disruption of traffic on Peninsula Boulevard; and it is

**FURTHER RESOLVED**, that such bus transportation program funding shall be a Proposition, or otherwise included in the proposed budget for 2015-2016 school year, which the District believes is necessary to protect the safety of the children attending the Prospect School.
