Nassau County Polling Place Agreement

WHEREAS, the District is in receipt of five (5) polling place agreements from the Nassau County Board of Elections (“Board of Elections”) for use of the David Paterson School, Barack Obama Elementary School, Alverta B. Gray Schultz Middle School, Joseph A. McNeil Elementary School, and the Jackson Main School for the following elections:

1. Primary Election – Tuesday June 24, 2025; and
2. Primary Election – Tuesday November 4, 2025; and

WHEREAS the Board of Elections requested the agreements be returned by January 28, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the requested return date does not provide sufficient time for the Board of Education to pass a resolution approving the agreements and providing the Board President authority to execute same; and

WHEREAS, due to the above-referenced circumstances, the Acting Superintendent of Schools executed the agreements on behalf of the District.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, upon the recommendation of the Acting Superintendent of Schools, the Board of Education hereby ratifies the polling place agreements between the District and the Board of Elections and provides the Acting Superintendent authority to execute said agreements, copies of which are annexed hereto.
