Education

GCSE (2024)

- 92% of our students attained grades 4 – 9 with a third of results being grade 9 - 7 (A* - A).

A-Level (2024)

- 90% of grades were awarded at A* - C, with over a quarter of results at A* - A.
- BTECs and vocational qualifications had a 100% pass rate with all grades being within the higher boundaries of Distinction* - Merit.

RIFA Philosophy

‘Total Football’ Approach

The RIFA 'total football' philosophy is one that emphasises supporting the whole person whilst playing attacking football with freedom and creativity.

Our holistic approach recognises that football development extends beyond the pitch. Our academy focuses not only on physical skills but also on mental resilience and character development. We aim to instil qualities such as leadership, sportsmanship, resilience and a strong work ethic that will benefit players both on and off the field.

We offer a bespoke individualised training programme ensuring the right balance is met from both a football and an academic perspective, set in a school with a reputation for the highest standards of pastoral care and excellent academic results.

Key Focus Areas

To develop a player’s understanding of the game as a whole, we focus on the following:

Skill Development

A focus on improving ball control, dribbling, passing, shooting and other technical skills essential for a successful football player.

Tactical Understanding

Learn the fundamentals of team play, positioning and strategy to understand the game at a deeper level and make intelligent decisions on the field.

Physical Conditioning

Fitness training programmes designed to enhance speed, agility, strength and stamina which is essential within top level football.

Individual Attention

Regular individualised feedback and guidance to help maximise potential and skills as a player.

Mental Preparation

Develop the right mindset, confidence and resilience to overcome challenges and perform at an elite level.



RIFA Training

Training sessions are part of RIFA students' weekly timetable, whether that be evening sessions, weekday sessions or offsite sessions at leading Premier League Clubs within 30 miles. All students have a rest day over the weekend, and will attend matches outside of school hours.

Our training sessions focus on these key development areas:



Ball Mastery

Control and manipulation of the ball on different training surfaces.

Passing, receiving & possession

Tempo, retention and risk.

Defending

Pressing and blocking; beginning a press, protecting goal, defending in and around the box, pressing in the middle and defensive third.

Attacking

Build up the play from back 4, goalkeeper situations, creating in final third, finishing, and building play with advanced full backs.

Transition

Counter attacking, regaining to exploit space in wide areas, recovering team shape to counter.

Constructive Feedback

Honest feedback to the development of all the skills mentioned to help players learn and develop mid-session.

Player Development Reviews

Every player excels with the right support system, whether it's from teammates, coaches, or their strongest supporters – their families. That's why we invite parents to join their child's termly development reviews with the Director of Football and coaching staff (via Zoom). During these reviews, we'll assess the student's strengths and areas for growth in five key areas: technical, tactical, physical, psychological and social development. Together, we'll create a clear, measurable development plan for the student to focus on in the upcoming term.

RIFA's tailored pathways help students achieve their football goals—whether in professional, semi-professional, or coaching roles.
