Initial Presentations

9th Grade Artes de Lenguaje (ALE)

- Viewed presentation on 9th grade Artes de Lenguaje.
- ALE compliments the ELA frameworks. It is a continuation from the K-6 curriculum.
- All of the units were created in Spanish and were then translated into English.
- The standards have to compliment the ELA curriculum not replicate.
- 4 days of PD, starting in June and an August DCD day.

Questions:

- Is the AP Spanish Language not a DL class? No, it is not.
- The theme for the entire year is advocacy and leadership? How will the students prepare for the 6 themes on the AP language exam?
 - o Many of the concepts are embedded in the curriculum.
- Will classrooms be blended with dual students and newcomers?
 - o Yes.
- This curriculum compliments ELA what do you mean by that?
 - o When we use the word compliment we mean add too. We don't want it to be the same
- Will the materials be available online?
 - o Some of the materials are available online.
- What about SPED DL, we are struggling with getting them the materials that they need.
 - We are in contact with Specialized student services.

Discussion:

- What is the rigor of the materials that will be in the classrooms?
 - The materials that we asked for were grade level materials. They could be used more for research.
- Was readability and text complexity part of the criteria?
 - o Yes, it was.

Informational Updates

MTSS

• Council received an update on the MTSS workgroups.

Questions:

- Who does the progress monitoring for students with IEP, who does that?
 - o If they have an active IEP it would be the IEP teacher, if it is just for speech then it would be the classroom teacher.
- Is there an expectation for Kindergarten intervention in math?
 - \circ No
- Are there early childhood teachers on the committee?
 - o No, there is one in the workgroup.
- With the emphasis on MTSS and the ALE presentation, has there been any conversation to examine the elementary general education core curriculum?
 - O Yes. A call to committee will be coming out soon to look at that.
- Why are Tier 2 and Tier 3 split in HS?
 - Our HS have a lot more kids and they have to effective and efficient.
- Why do only certain elementary schools have MTSS leads?
 - o Those schools were the targeted group.
- Can PIT be brought into the MTSS discussion?
 - We can have future conversations, but this has currently not been part of the conversations.
- Are all schools doing the same interventions?
 - We are for the most part the most uniform we have been.
- Are you allowing some flexibility?
 - o Our goal is to have all the same interventions in English and in Spanish.

Dual Language High School Follow up

- Council received a follow up on staffing implications, when DL is rolled up to high school.
- With our initial staffing we are looking for 16 DL teachers, but that is overall district wide not just at the high school level.

Questions:

- Will Biology classes be capped at a lower number?
 - o It depends on the high school and their Biology classroom structure.
- Could some of the Dual Language openings be filled by a current U-46 teacher?
 - Yes. If they are moving from a Gen Ed classroom to a DL classroom.
- Would the DL positions be posted?
 - Yes. Everything is posted and everyone has to apply online.

Review of Discovery Corps PD

- Council viewed presentation of Discovery Corps PD.
- 60 teachers across the district will be participating.
- Teacher PD consists of a 3 year plan.
- There will be 5 core learning days and 10 instructional support days and ongoing virtual support.

• Administrators will receive 2 core learning days of training.

Questions:

- This is at the high school level?
 - o Yes.
- How are teachers going to be selected?
 - o There will be a call to committee and we will come up with a selection process.
- Can this be offered to all teachers?
 - We would love to, but aren't able to, but all teachers will have PD around technology.
- Did this PD vision come from the teachers or was it from the top down?
 - o This really did start with the teachers.
- Is this model sustainable? A lot of the time teachers leave and then there isn't anyone in the building available to train.
 - We will want to find teachers who are in this for the long haul.
- How can elementary buildings benefit from this PD?
 - We are going to start at the HS level, as it rolls down we will consider doing something similar with the elementary schools.
- Are teachers getting release time?
 - o They will get time to do the PD.
- What will the learning labs look like?
 - o A learning lab is a model classroom. Any person from the district can come in and see what the interaction is.

RENZ Curriculum

• Council moved into groups and reviewed chapters from the RENZ curriculum.

Discussion:

- It seems this curriculum goes against everything ACE stands for.
- This was written by clinicians not educators. This is not for everybody.
- If we are concerned with some of the items in the document, we will probably have a problem with some of the PowerPoints, which are referenced.
- Some of this material is already addressed in the Health classroom.
- Should there be a parental permission slip? Some parents would not like this to be shared with their children.
