Our school is scheduled to take the Wisconsin Forward April 8, 9, 10, 17 and 18. For exact testing times, check with your child's teacher. The specific dates, subject and length of test are as follows:

Students will use their school-issued Chromebooks for the assessment.

The Wisconsin Forward assessment tests students in the areas of English/Language Arts (ELA) and Math and specific grade levels in Science and Social Studies (4th, 8th, and 10th grades). One or more subtests may be administered daily during the identified time frame and it is very important your son or daughter be in school during this time.

The Wisconsin Forward assessment measures the knowledge and skills your student(s) should have acquired by the time they reach each grade level. Their performance on the assessment will not affect any of their current grades. Please encourage your son or daughter to take the test seriously and do the best they can. The results of these tests will assist school staff to make instructional decisions to best support your child(ren)'s learning.
