Our attendance has continued to hover right around 95% as a school. Let's keep up the good work. The goal is 95% or higher!

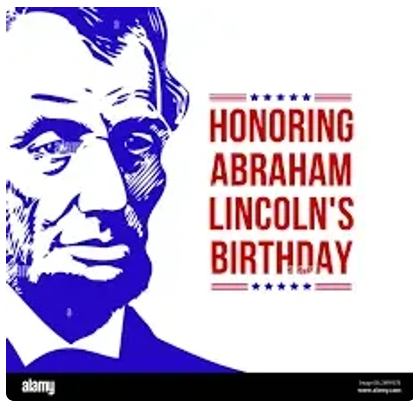
