Legacy of Mary E. Britton

Physician, Educator, Suffragist, Journalist, Civil Rights Leader



First African-American to teach white students at Berea College



Advocated for better teaching practices in African-American schools



Argued for women's rights and spoke out against many bills that prohibited women's rights



Created Colored Orphan Industrial Home that provided food, shelter, education and training to destitute orphans and elderly, homeless women until 1988



First African-American female doctor in Kentucky
