

Scenario #1



You're dropping off your child at school

You see a student who is being approached by a male adult that you do not recognize

The student is crying and attempting to walk away, but being held by the arm

STOP-THINK-ACT

Discuss with neighbor



Scenario #2



Your child approaches you at dinner, showing you an Instagram post

The post is a photo of a fellow student you know well who is holding what appears to be a hand gun with verbiage of "Don't go to School on Friday"

STOP-THINK- ACT

Discuss with neighbor



Scenario #3



Your child comes home and reports that they shared with administration of a writing on the bathroom stall:

"Threat of a bomb to go off in the near future"

STOP- THINK- ACT

Discuss with neighbor



Investigation



- Review the surveillance cameras to identify
- Interview potential witnesses, victims and offenders
- Work with law enforcement partners on the severity
- Request extra presence of school administrators and law enforcement
- Communication with staff, families, and consistent with law enforcement
- Overall challenges with communication?
