- I. Call to order: Meeting called to order at 7:01pm. Meeting was held inperson and via Zoom. Members of CAC Executive committee, representatives of School District U-46 and guests were in attendance. The meeting was recorded for future viewing.

- III. **Board of Education Update:** Provided by Board Member Dawn Martin. Saturday night is U-46 Night for the Windy City Bulls.
