Green Bay Preble High School invites you to attend the student-athlete signing on Wednesday, February 5, 2025 at 9:20 a.m. in the High School LMC. The public and media are invited to attend.

Killian Arlt is a senior standout athlete that has participated in the sports of cross country and track while attending Preble High School.

Killian was a four year varsity letter winner in cross country at Preble. He earned First Team All Conference this past season and Second Team All Conference as a junior. He was a two time State Qualifier. He was a part of the Preble Cross Country Team that was two time Conference Champions, two time WIAA Sectional Champions, and placed 3rd in the 2024 WIAA State Championship. In track, Killian earned Second Team All Conference last year and was an alternate on the State qualifying 4x8 Relay Team. He is also involved in Academic Decathlon, where he is a two time State qualifier and a National Medalist, and Link Crew. Killian has been on the Honor Roll every year.

Killian will attend the University of Wisconsin Stevens Point where he will participate in cross country and track. The Head Coach is Thomas Bambach and is entering his third year at UWSP in 2024-25. Brett Witt enters his 11th season at UW-Stevens Point as the Head Track and Field Coach in 2024-25. In 2024, Witt oversaw 12 NCAA National Championship qualifiers and six who finished with All-America honors between the indoor and outdoor seasons.

Killian is the son of Susie & Joel Kabacinski and Jon & Katie Arlt and has three siblings - Kaden, Keirsten and Molly.

Jack Dahlke is a senior standout athlete that has participated in the sports of football, baseball and track while attending Preble High School.

Jack received Second Team All Conference Honors as an Offensive Lineman in 2024 and is on the Football Leadership Council. He is also involved in Preble Pride and is a member of the Student Council. Jack has been on the High Honor Roll four times and the Honor Roll three times while at Preble.

Jack will attend Carroll University where he will participate in football. Mike Budziszewski was named the 30th head football coach in program history on January 5, 2020. The 2024 season will be Budziszewski's fifth year at the helm of the Pioneers. Budziszewski coached 10 All-Conference players in 2023, with three of those also earning All-Region honors and one being named CCIW First-year Defensive Student-Athlete of the Year. He also helped the Pioneers break six single season individual and team records that year, including points scored (364) and total offensive yards (4,027).

Jack is the son of Scott and Jennifer and has one sister Lauren.

Gabrielle Haller is a senior standout athlete that has participated in the sports of cross country and track while attending Preble High School.

Gabrielle earned Cross Country First Team All Conference honors three times and Honorable Mention All Conference one year. She was a part of the Cross Country team that was Conference Champion, two time WIAA Sectional Champion and placed 8th at this year's WIAA State Meet. In track, Gabrielle earned First Team All Conference in the 800 M Run and the 4x800 M Relay. She has qualified for the WIAA State Meet in the 4x800 M Relay three times and the 800 M Run. Gabrielle has also earned Academic All State in Cross Country her junior and senior year.

Gabrielle will attend the University of Wisconsin Green Bay as a preferred walk on where she will participate in cross country. The Head Coach is Mike Kline and he is going into his 38th year in the 2024-25 season as the Head Coach of Green Bay men's and women's cross country teams. Kline landed the Green Bay coaching position in 1987 while he was still a cross country student-athlete at UWGB.

Gabrielle is the daughter of David and Gina and has three siblings - Ellyse, Camille and Truitt.

Branson Kent is a senior standout athlete that has participated in the sport of baseball while attending Preble High School.

Branson received Preble Rookie of the Year as a Sophomore and Preble Utility Player of the Year as a Junior. While at Preble, Branson has participated in AVID, Gear Up, National Honor Society, Intramural Basketball and is a Rising Phoenix Student. He has also been on the High Honor Roll every semester.

Branson will attend Lawrence University where he will participate in baseball. The Head Coach is Trent Whitcomb who is in his 1st season with the Vikings.

Branson is the son of Tracy and James and has one brother Aspen.

Yahye Mohamed is a senior standout athlete that has participated in the sports of cross country and track while attending Preble High School.

Yahye earned Second Team All Conference this past season. This past year, he was a part of the Preble Cross Country Team that won the Conference Championship, won the WIAA Sectional Championship, and placed 3rd at the WIAA State Meet.

Yahye will attend the University of Wisconsin Stout where he will participate in cross country and track. Matt Schauf was named the ninth head coach of the UW-Stout men's cross country and the seventh head coach of the women's country teams in July 2007. Schauf is also the distance coach for the Blue Devils' men's and women's track teams. In his 18 seasons at UW-Stout the Blue Devils have had at least one individual qualify to the national cross country national championship since 2010.

Yahye is the son of Abdi Dahir and Fos Diriye and has four siblings - Faysal, Khalid, Iqra, and Abdale

Ben Piontek is a senior standout athlete that has participated in the sports of cross country and track while attending Preble High School.

Ben earned Honorable Mention All Conference honors in 2022 and First Team All Conference honors in 2023 and 2024. He was a part of the Preble Cross Country Team that was two time Conference Champions, two time WIAA Sectional Champions, and placed 3rd in the 2024 WIAA State Championship. In track, Ben was a two time WIAA Sectional

qualifier and was a WIAA State Meet qualifier last year. He is also a member of the Preble Orchestra. Ben has been on the Honor Roll.

Ben will attend the University of Wisconsin Whitewater where he will participate in cross country and track. The Head Coach is Jeff Miller and he has been coaching at UW-Whitewater since the fall of 1982. Miller is the head coach for both the men's and women's cross country teams as well as an assistant coach for the men's track team. Miller took over the men's cross country team in 1982 and is the longest tenured cross country coach that UW-Whitewater has ever had. Since 1982, Miller has led the men's team to two runner-up finishes and five third-place finishes in the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference. The Warhawk men won the program's first-ever regional team championship in 2021.

Ben is the son of Todd and Heather and has a brother Max.

Dominic Prince is a senior standout athlete that has participated in the sports of football, wrestling and golf while attending Preble High School.

Dominic has been on the High Honor Roll every year and has a 3.8 GPA.

Dominic will attend St. Norbert College where he will participate in football. Dan McCarty is in his ninth season as St. Norbert College's head football coach in 2024. The Green Knights are 59-24 in McCarty's tenure. The Green Knights went 7-4 in 2023, appearing in the Cousins Subs Lakefront Bowl at the end of the season.

Dominic is the son of Tawni and Ben and has one sister Leila.

Braylon Schadt is a senior standout athlete that has participated in the sport of football and track while attending Preble High School.

Braylon received Second Team All Conference Honors as a Receiver in 2024. He has set the record for most career receptions, most career receiving yards and most receptions in one game at Preble. Braylon was Preble's Offensive Player of the Year in 2023 and 2024 and he also received the 2024 Offseason Hardest Worker Award.

Braylen will attend the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh where he will participate in football. Peter Jennings enters his third as the head coach of the UW-Oshkosh Titans in 2024 with a 12-8 overall record and a 8-6 record in WIAC contests. Jennings is the 23rd head coach in the 129-year history of the UW-Oshkosh football program that has produced 11 WIAC titles and five NCAA Division III Championship appearances, including a trip to the 2016 national title game.

Braylen is the son of Robin and has one brother Mykaiel.

Calvin Veriha is a senior standout athlete that has participated in the sports of football, wrestling and track while attending Preble High School.

Calvin received First Team All Conference Honors as a Defensive End in 2023 & 2024 and WFC A All Region Team as a Defensive End in 2024. He received the 2024 Preble Team Captain Award, 2024 Preble Best Lineman Award and the 2023 Preble Team Defensive MVP Award. Calvin has been on the High Honor Roll every year and earned a 31 on his ACT.

Calvin will attend the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh where he will participate in football. Peter Jennings enters his third as the head coach of the UW-Oshkosh Titans in 2024 with a 12-8 overall record and a 8-6 record in WIAC contests. Jennings is the 23rd head coach in the 129-year history of the UW-Oshkosh football program that has produced 11 WIAC titles and five NCAA Division III Championship appearances, including a trip to the 2016 national title game.

Randy Von Haden is a senior standout athlete that has participated in the sports of football, hockey and baseball while attending Preble High School.

Randy has been on the High Honor Roll every semester.

Randy will attend Marian University where he will participate in baseball. The Head Coach is Jordan Baitinger and was named the head coach of the Marian baseball program in the summer of 2016 becoming just the fourth head coach since the program's inception in 1988. Baitinger had spent the previous four seasons as an assistant coach for the program and leading the pitching staff. He quickly turned the program around to begin his tenure and in 2018 led Marian to a second place finish in the NACC going 13-7 in conference action earning him NACC Coach of the Year recognition.
