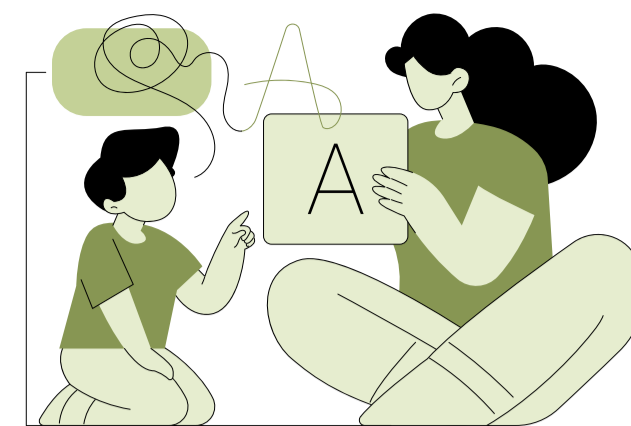


Live Lessons

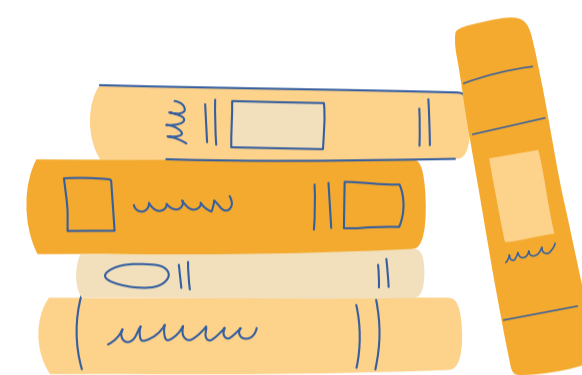
