- Make sure you have completed your 1 credit requirement or are choosing classes for next year to meet this
- Any AP class other than AP Seminar
- Dual College Credit - 1 credit total (Courses #'s have a W on transcript)
- CTE Concentrator : For class of 2026 only (Course #'s in 8000's)
 - 1 credit in a single CTE Program

Expectations

- If you fail a core class, you will have to retake it - YOU WILL NOT ADVANCE
- NOT a lot of room to fail
- Passing grades : D and above
- Behave - Your actions have consequences

How else can I earn credits?

- Online courses in 4C
 - APEX
 - Edynamics
- Sports - In-school/club sports = .5 credit (1 cred MAX)
- Work Experience - Every 120 hrs that you work = .5 elective credit per term
- Youth Court = .5 credit in Social Studies
- Volunteer Experience - 120 hrs = .5 elective credit
- College Coursework - (.5 HS cr/1 cr college course , 1 hs cr./3-4 cr college course, 1.5 hs cr. / 5-6 cr college course)
- Credit Repair - 4 days (Students who failed a semester 2 class with a 44.9% or +)

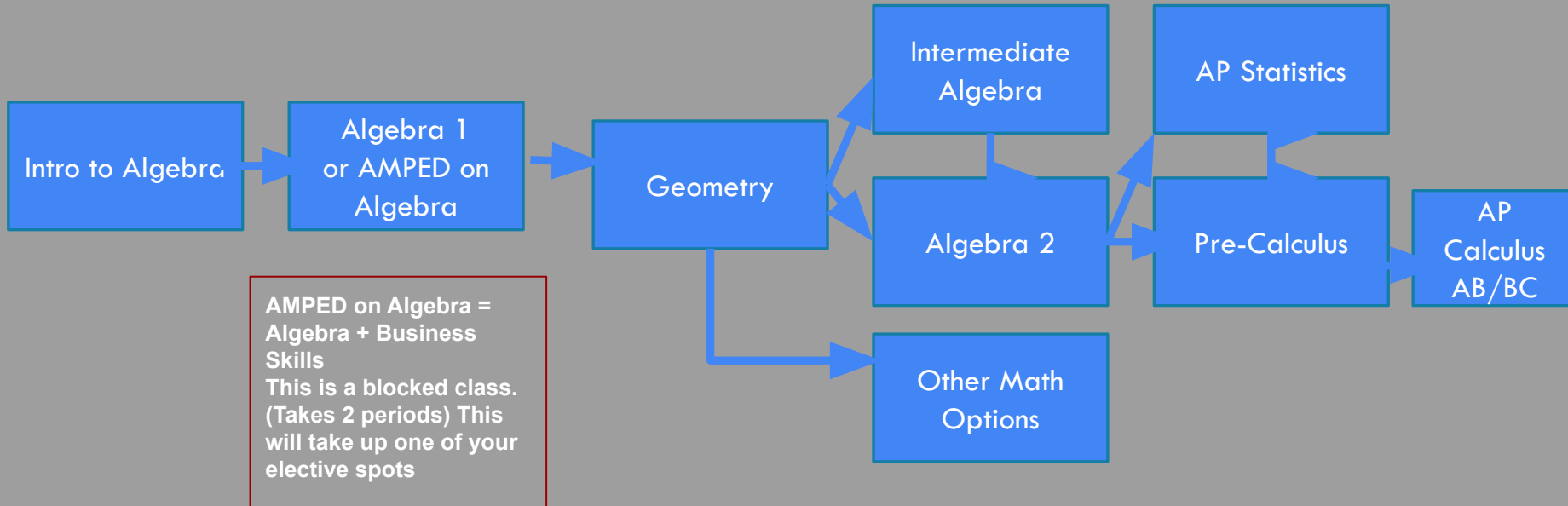

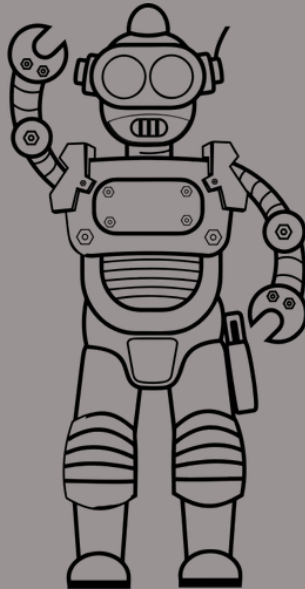
- 1 season of a sport = .5 credit of PE

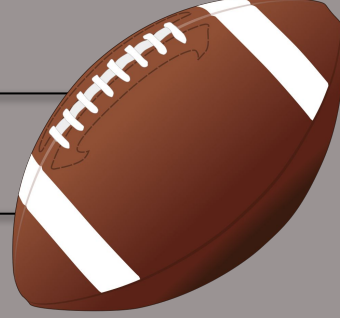

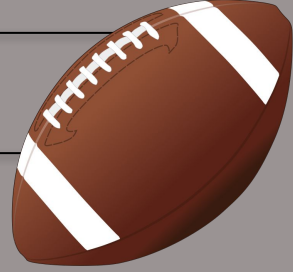

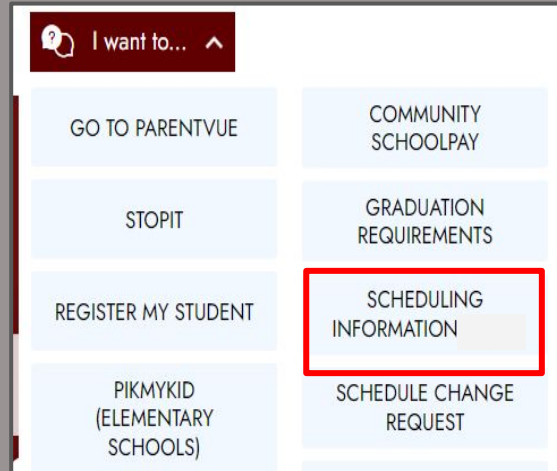
