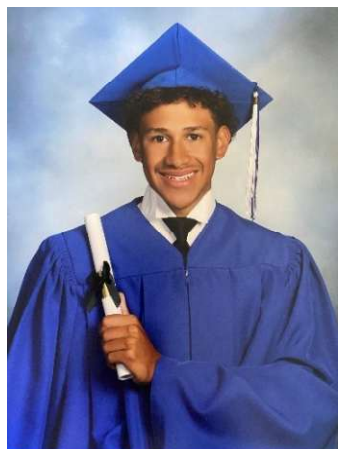

What is your favorite subject?

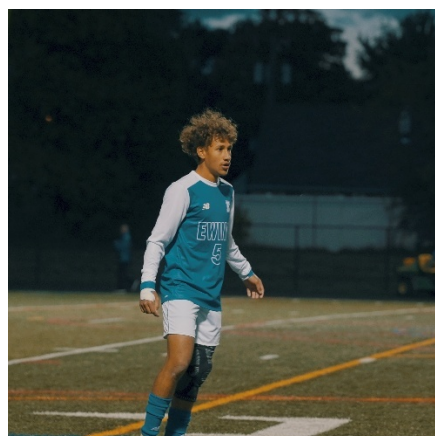
Undeniably social studies. I have taken five classes in the social studies department and will say they are the most fun and have the best teachers. They are extremely wise and provide a great environment for students to learn.
