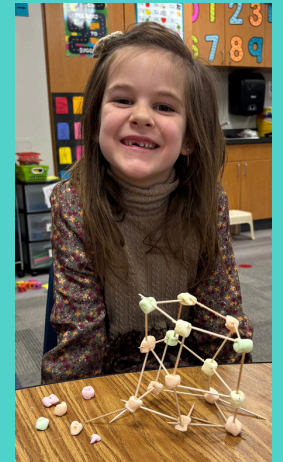
100 DAYS SMARTER
