



Davie County Schools Board of Education Seeks Public Input on Superintendent Search

Mocksville, N.C., February 5, 2025 - Davie County Schools Board of Education has hired the North Carolina School Boards Association (NCSBA) to help facilitate its search for the next superintendent of Davie County Schools (DCS). The board is seeking direct input from interested students, parents, community members, and staff to help shape the search process and to assist in defining the characteristics, experience, and skills desired in the next DCS superintendent.

Community Survey - The board invites students, parents, and other members of the community to participate in a community survey that can be accessed and completed online by clicking the superintendent search survey link on the DCS website: <https://www.godavie.org/>. All surveys must be completed by Wednesday, February 19, 2025, with results to be compiled, summarized, and presented by NCSBA at the DCS regularly scheduled board meeting on March 4, 2025.

Staff Survey - In addition, all DCS employees will have an opportunity to complete a separate online staff survey. Details about completing the employee version of the superintendent search survey will be communicated via school system email. All surveys must be completed by Wednesday, February 19, 2025, with results to be compiled, summarized, and presented by NCSBA at the DCS regularly scheduled board meeting on March 4, 2025.

Statements from Community Groups and Organizations - In addition to input received from the surveys, local groups and organizations may submit written statements regarding the leadership qualities that they consider important in the next superintendent. Such statements should be submitted directly to NCSBA via e-mail at sthorp@ncsba.org and should be received no later than Wednesday, February 19, 2025.
