Perishables and Seasonal Commodities:

Pursuant to the provisions of Education Code Section 39873, all vegetables, meats, and dairy products are defined as perishable commodities under the meanings of that section. Bids for these items and seasonal commodities, including canned goods, may be accepted in written, oral, formal or informal manner. Purchases may be made from bids or on the open market, whichever method appears to be most advantageous to the District.

Non-Perishables:

If the estimate of the cost of work to be done is over \$8,000, or if any of the estimates of the cost of materials or supplies to be furnished, sold or leased to the district are more than \$12,000, it shall be advertised at least two weeks in advance in a regularly established newspaper or approved publication. Such bids shall be advertised at least two weeks in advance in a regularly established newspaper or approved publication. Such bids shall be opened publicly at a point designated by the Chief Accountant and award shall be made to the lowest responsible bidder.

The Superintendent is directed to establish regulations to insure that the intent of this policy is accomplished in an effective and orderly manner.
