Subject: Transportation Routes & Services

Walking distances to a school or bus stop are:

Grades 9-12 2 Miles

Students who reside beyond the walking distance shall be eligible for transportation service to their school of residence.

The Superintendent or designee may authorize transportation within the minimum distance when special problems or hazards exist.

The Superintendent or designee shall design school routes and stops which meet safety guidelines set forth by the California Highway Patrol. Bus routes will be reviewed annually for safety, access, and compliance to other aspects of this board policy.

Pupils who are attending schools in the District under an interdistrict or intra district agreement will provide their own transportation.

District transportation may be provided for transportation of athletics and field trips. Such trips will be timed so that they do not disrupt home-to-school transportation. All rules and regulations which pertain to home-to-school transportation apply to athletics and field trips.
