Subject: Curriculum

The curricula of the Liberty Union High School District shall be in harmony with the Governing Board's adopted goals and legal requirements.

Curriculum development by the certificated staff shall be guided by such factors as the following:

Actual studies and information concerning the needs of students in this school district.

The range of abilities, aptitudes and interests of the district's students.

Aspirations of residents of the school district for the district's students.

The mobility of our population, making it necessary to provide education for the district's students useful anywhere in the world.

Avoidance of discrimination.

The Governing Board desires the unnecessary duplication of work among the various grade levels be eliminated, and that courses of study and syllabi be coordinated effectively.

The Governing Board favors providing opportunities for faculty to consult and assist in curriculum development through such devices as workshops, study groups, assistance from outside consultants, and extended employment to allow teaching staff to devote other than regular contract time to the task.

The Governing Board reserves the responsibility for establishing curricula for the school district. All teachers shall teach within the approved curricula and course of study.
