Alternative Course of Studies

Applied Academic Academy (AAA) Pathway

The Applied Academic Academy provides a modified curriculum that does not meet the rigor of high school standards. Students must complete the required 270 credits and take, but not pass, the California state assessments. Students are required to participate in the School to Employment Program (STEP), a series of vocationally focused elective courses. Students are awarded a Certificate of Educational Achievement upon completion of the requirements. Students remain eligible for special education services to age 22.

Lifeskills Program (Severely Handicapped)

The Lifeskills Program provides a functional academic and independent living curriculum. Students are accountable for IEP goals and objectives and their individual transition plan. Students who successfully complete this program are awarded a Certificate of Completion upon completion of 270 units. Students remain eligible for special education services to age 22.
