### 1.0 Criteria

1.1 Department chairpersons from the core and alternate subject area work together to identify common behavioral objectives.

1.1.1 Core curriculum: English, math, science, social studies

1.2 Alternate curriculum must meet 75% - 80% of core course curriculum objectives to earn ten (10) units of core curriculum credit for two semesters.

1.3 Alternate curriculum which meets less than 75% - 80% of core course curriculum objectives may earn five (5) units of core credit for two semesters.

1.4 Alternate curriculum which substantially meets the goals of the core subject area curriculum and the state frameworks may also be considered for alternate credit.

1.5 Disagreements will be negotiated with the Director of Curriculum.

### 2.0 Application for credit

2.1 Department chairpersons from the core and alternate subject area meet with Director of Curriculum to review course content.

2.2 Department chairpersons sign Cross-Curricular Credit Consent Form agreeing to cross-curricular credit.

2.3 Request for cross-curricular credit is reviewed by District Cabinet.

2.4 District cabinet makes recommendation to the Liberty Union High School District School Board.

### 3.0 Monitoring

3.1 Students receiving cross-curricular credit will be monitored to assure that:

- a. they are as prepared as the general population for core courses that follow in sequence
- b. they pass District Proficiency tests at the same rate as the general student population.

3.2 Alternate credit may be reconsidered and reviewed at the request of either subject area department chairpersons, the Director of Curriculum, or the Board of Trustees.
