Challenging Courses by Examinations

The School Board recognizes the occasional need to allow students to challenge a given course by examination in order to permit students to enroll in courses best suited to their educational objectives.

The examination given to students under this policy shall be a comprehensive examination which shall cover all of the objectives of the course being challenged. Successful completion of the examination shall be at a level which indicates mastery of the content and/or reasonable chance for success in the next higher course. Students may not challenge required courses which include district content standards and benchmarks.

Procedures for course challenges shall be developed by the Superintendent or his designee and shall be made available to the students upon request.
