Subject: P.A.S.S. Independent Study Program

Under the direction of the site principal or designee, migrant students may participate in the P.A.S.S. independent study program within the following guidelines:

1. Students may earn P.A.S.S. credits toward graduation only if they have enrolled in a district class after the beginning of a term/semester or leave the class prior to the end of a term/semester due to their physical relocation outside the district for migrant activities. (Class 1 and qualifying Class 2 migrant education students)
2. P.A.S.S. courses must be completed within one year/two semesters of the relocation.
3. Students wishing to enroll in P.A.S.S. classes shall complete the Liberty Union High School District Migrant Education P.A.S.S. Program Application form and receive a signature of approval from the Principal or Assistant Principal or Guidance Services prior to enrollment.
4. Students may not receive more than a total of 90 units toward graduation in any school calendar year.
5. Students may not enroll in classes in advance of their grade level status; i.e. U.S. History - Junior, American Government - Senior, English IV - Senior.
6. Students who do not qualify for the P.A.S.S. Program shall be referred to existing Liberty Union High School District alternative education classes to assure their timely progress toward graduation.
