
Registration is now open!



The Delta Community Services (DCS) Brentwood High School Scholarship Program is intended to provide support to graduating high school seniors who are in need of financial support to continue their education in an accredited Vocational/Trade School, Community College, or University. The initial program will provide:

Three \$1,200 scholarships for 3 graduating seniors from each school below:

- Heritage High School
- Liberty High School
- Freedom High School

One \$1,000 scholarship for 1 graduating senior from each school below:
