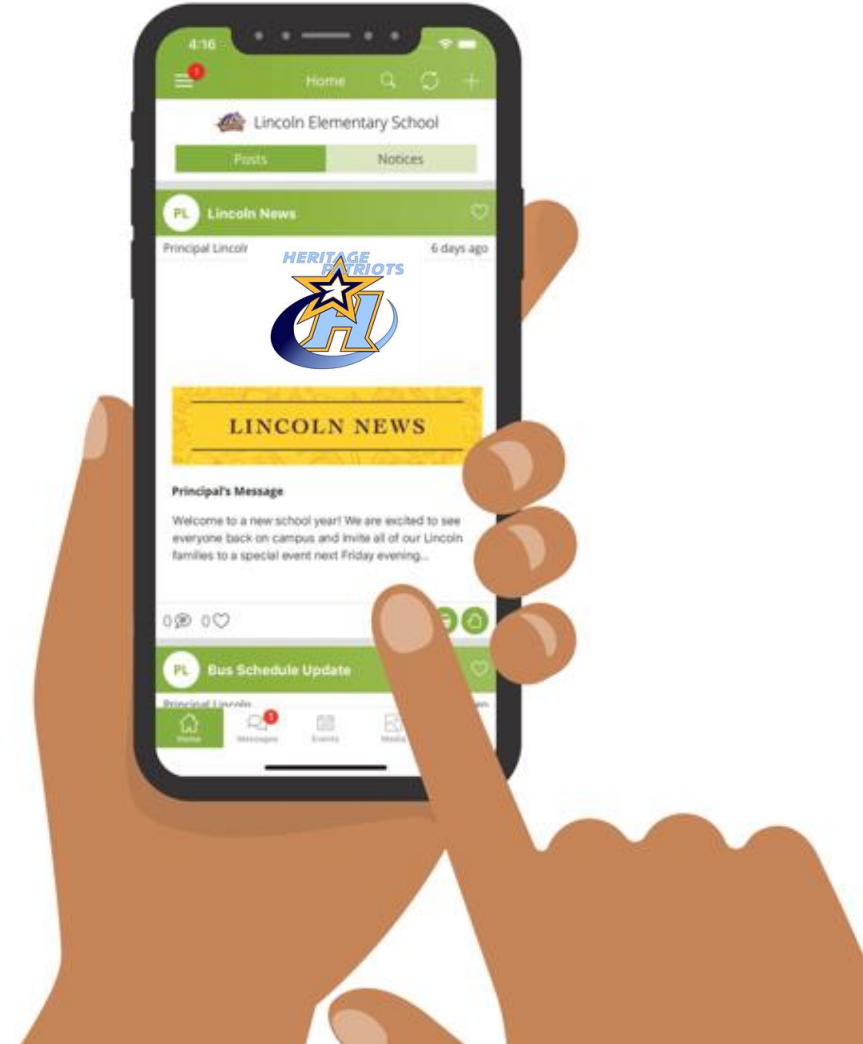

## A- G Subject Requirements



Subjects	Min. Requirements of College Preparatory Courses
A. History/Social Science	2 years: <a href="#">World History, U.S. History, Government</a>
B. English	4 years: College Prep <a href="#">English 9-12</a>
C. Math	3 Years of college prep math, 4 years is highly recommended <a href="#">Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra II</a>
D. Laboratory Science	2 years of lab science 3 years of lab science is recommended: <a href="#">Living Earth, Chemistry, Physics</a>
E. Language other than English	2 years of the same language, 3 years is recommended <a href="#">Spanish, French</a>
F. Visual/Performing Arts	1 year of a college prep course <a href="#">Art, Music, Theater</a>
G. College Preparatory Elective	1 year of a college prep elective <a href="#">Psychology, Speech and Debate, Creative Writing, etc.</a>
Test Requirements	SAT or ACT

## Zen Den

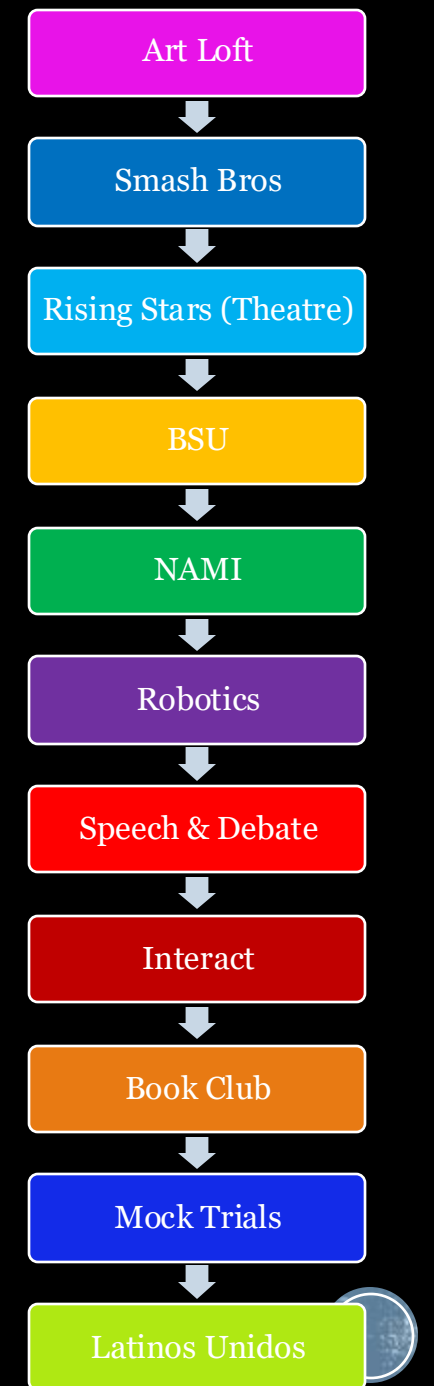
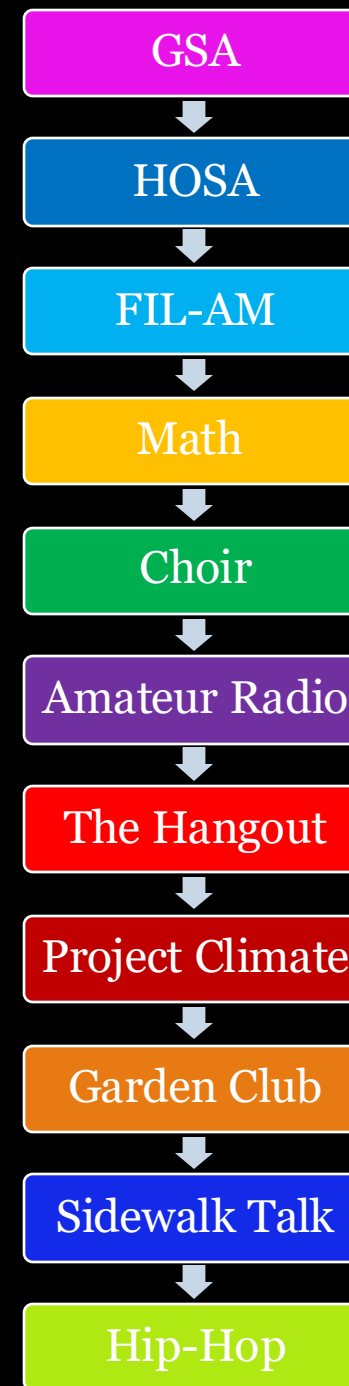
The Zen Den provides a safe space for emotional regulation and private discussions. Students are allowed a 15-minute break per day
