

Students are not allowed to drop Honors, Pre-AP, Statewide Dual Credit (SDC), Advanced Placement (AP) and Dual Enrollment (DE) courses. Therefore, it is recommended to have a 90 or higher average in the prerequisite class due to the academic rigor.

Lastly, I have reviewed the course description in the Program of Studies and have taken the appropriate prerequisite for the above course(s).

For Advanced Placement (AP) courses only: I/we understand that students are required to pay for and take the AP exam in May. A payment of \$105 per AP class is required by November 1, 2025. Students who do not pay for and/or take the AP exam in May will not have the quality points added to their semester averages.

For Dual Enrollment (DE) courses only: Enrollment is contingent on meeting University of Memphis's requirements based on ACT scores and admissions index (see course description). Verification for enrollment will be completed mid-May. Students are required to maintain a "2.0" college average in the class to continue receiving funding from the State of Tennessee's lottery funds. The 2.0 college average is in accordance with the post-secondary institutions grading system. Students who fall below a "2.0" college average, will be placed in the high school equivalent course for 2nd semester. Funding amounts are subject to change.
