- 1. Read the third scene of Antigone.
- 2. Better understand how complex characters' beliefs and motivations interact to advance the plot or develop and theme.
- 3. Be able to identify and analyze the meaning and effect of figurative language in a complex text.

- 3. Packet:
  - a. The packet is structured in the same way as the past two weeks and should be familiar. However, please don't forget to include textual evidence in your response to the analysis questions.
  - b. While most of my students have been able to use the fillable PDFs without any problems, many of you have had trouble with them. I make the PDFs to make your lives easier, so if you have trouble with them, feel free to complete your work in another way. Here are a couple of options:
    - i. Type your work in a separate document such as Word, Pages, or Docs and submit your work to Turnitin.com.

    - i. Once you have done that, you review what your peers have posted and respond to two posts you find interesting. A valid response might include:
      - 1. Agreeing with the post and explaining with what it is you agree.
      - 2. Clarifying the post and explaining why the post needs clarification.
      - 3. Disagreeing with the post and explaining with what you disagree.
  - c. To clarify, for this assignment, you will need to post 1 questions and respond to 2 of your peers posts.
  - d. Please be respectful when using the discussion board. Demeaning, off topic, or offensive posts will be deleted and the poster will receive a failing grade for the assignment.
