5. Discussion Board:

- Post your opinion on a moment or event:
 - After reading chapter 7, think about a moment or event that you found interesting, wonderful, terrible, or just strange.
 - Make a post describing this moment or event and explain why you hold your opinion on it.
- Reply to a post:
 - Once you have done that, review what your peers have posted and respond to any posts you find interesting. A valid response might include:
 - Agreeing with the post and explaining with what it is you agree.
 - Disagreeing with the post and explaining with what you disagree.
 - Pointing out context or details that the original post did not include.
