**National Honor Society Community Service Requirement**

To be an **Active Member of NHS**, you must keep your *Grade Point Average* above 3.25 (3.50 for graduation recognition), attend meetings, participate in activities, and complete a minimum of 20 hours of a service project during each school year (min. 10 hours each semester). There is also a group community service opportunity (sophomores are exempt from this requirement).

You must complete the 20 hour minimum of community service, fill in your time card and get it signed by a site-supervisor. Next, write a one-page reflection of your experience(s) and provide a photo. Finally, email your reflection and photo to Mr. Hollister and turn in your time card to Mr. Hollister, in room B204.
