Clarity and PVAAS

PVAAS (Pennsylvania Value-Added Assessment System) is a data tool used by the Pennsylvania Department of Education (PDE) to measure student academic growth over time. It helps educators assess the impact of their instructional practices by analyzing how much progress students make year over year, rather than just their achievement at a single point in time.

Clarity in Community Aspirations - Aligning Goals with PVAAS

PVAAS data helps our team align instructional strategies with community expectations by identifying learner growth trends and ensuring equitable progress.

Clarity in Vision → Setting Data-Driven Improvement Goals

A clear vision for learner success requires measurable targets, and PVAAS provides insights to refine curriculum and interventions accordingly.

Clarity in Journey Path - Guiding Instruction with Data

By tracking learner growth over time, PVAAS helps us adjust strategies to support all learners effectively.

Clarity in Communication → Transparency in Data Use

PVAAS fosters a common language for discussing learner progress, ensuring stakeholders understand how data informs decisions.


PVAAS answers the question:

Key for Reading PVAAS Growth Charts




