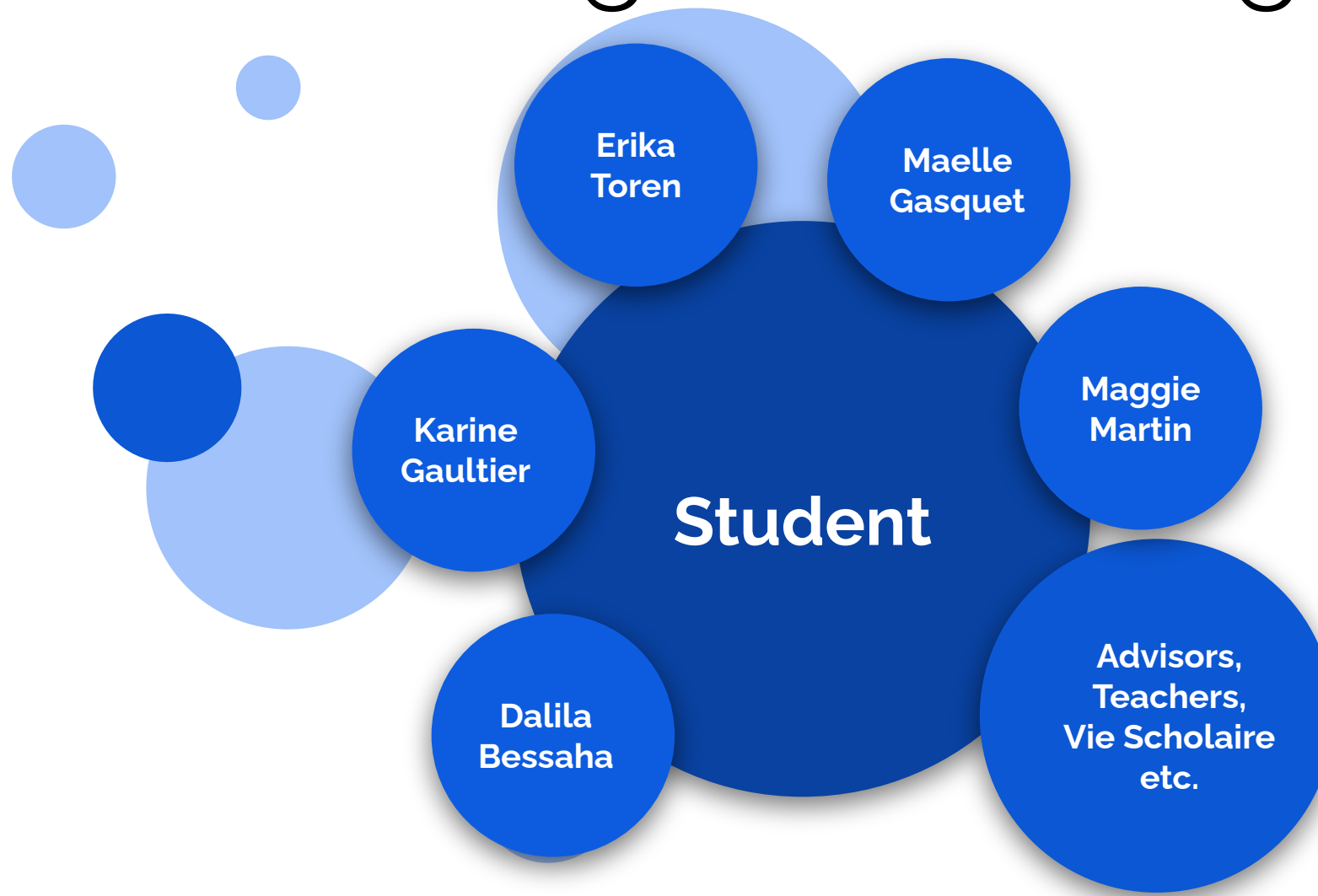

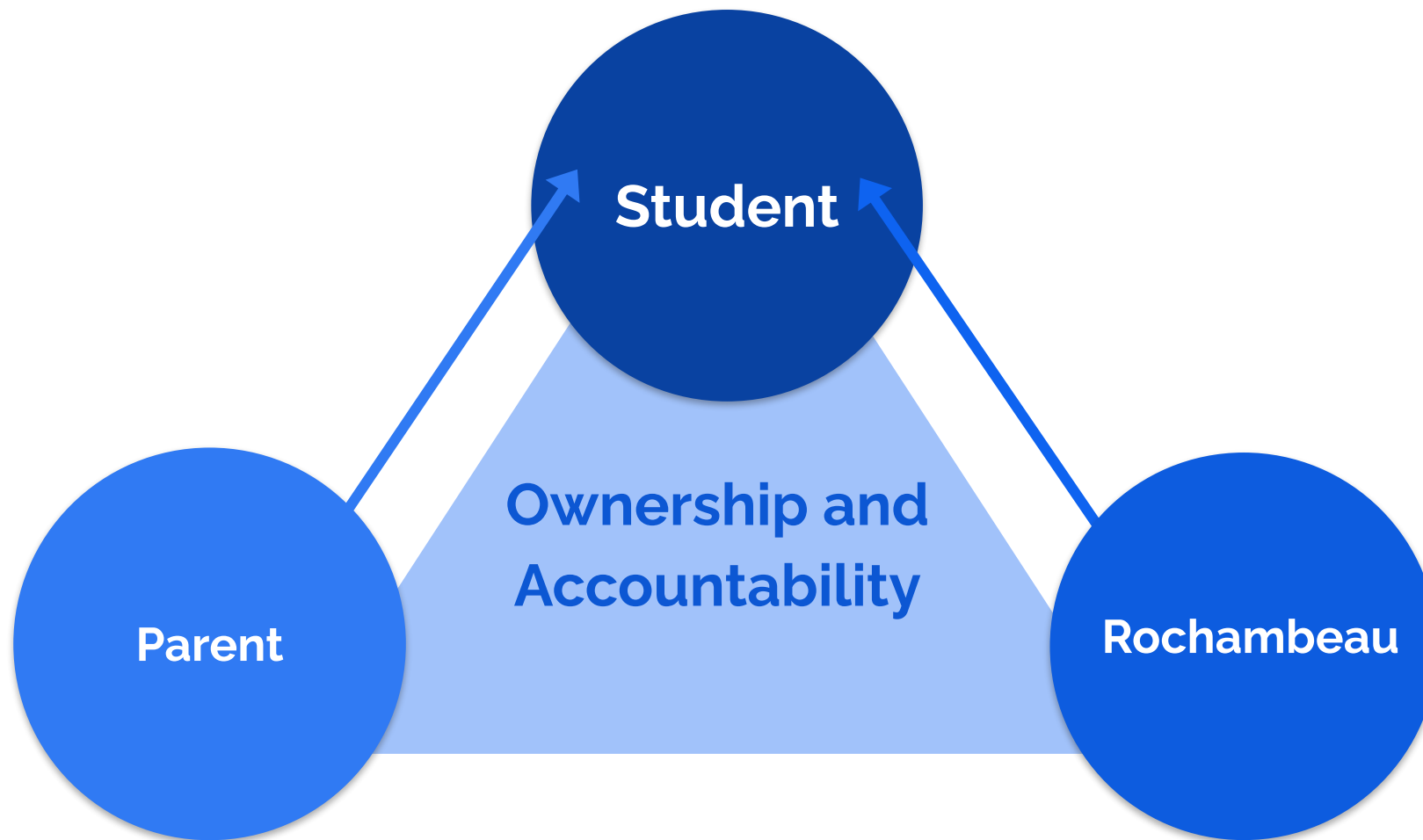

Leadership, resilience, and a compelling personal story.

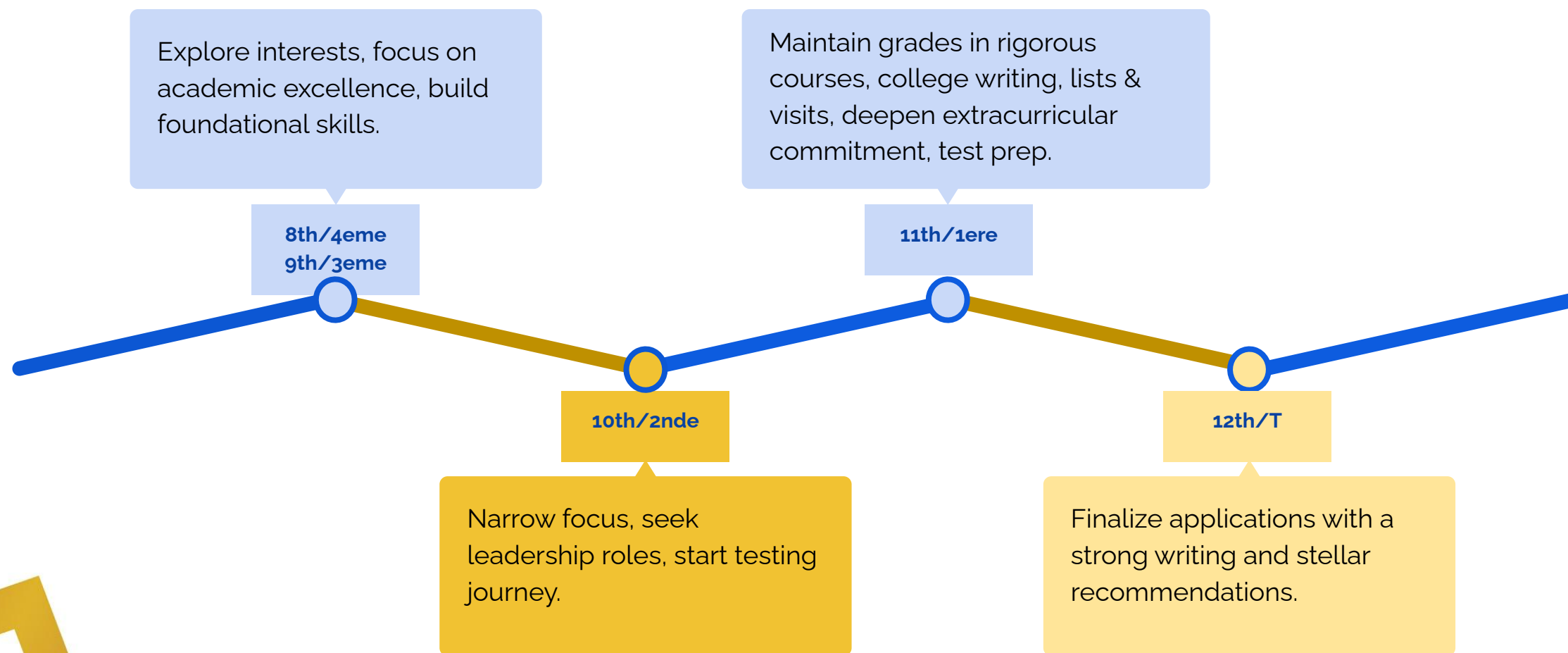


Laying the Foundation: 2nde

Starting the process late

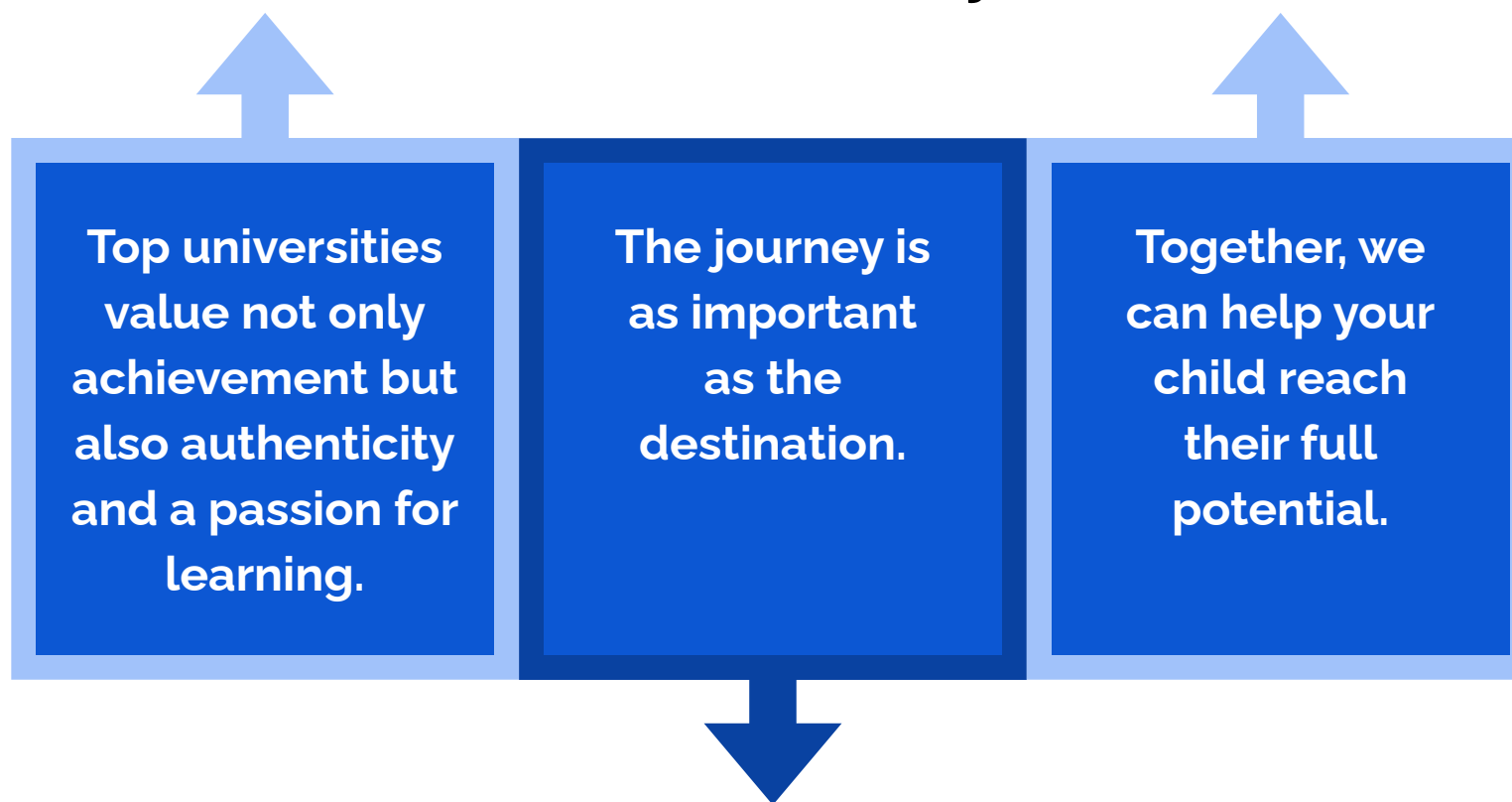
