

Genesis Academy Student/Parent Agreement & Student Learning Plan

I, _____ (print first & last name), agree to all school, classroom, internet and discipline rules as set forth in the Prescott High School Student/Parent handbook ([LINK](#)) and in the school internet agreement. This includes academic dishonesty or fraudulent activities. Due to the nature of Genesis, any violation of these rules can result in being withdrawn from Genesis Academy.

By enrolling in Genesis:

I understand that after enrolling in Genesis Academy, I will not be able to return to Prescott High School. There may be some special circumstances where a student is allowed to return to Prescott High School- these circumstances will only be considered on a case by case basis, and requires approval by the Administrative Team at Prescott High School. If you have intent to return to Prescott High School, you must let the Director of Genesis Academy (Ms. Tymchak- christina.tymchak@prescottschools.com) know via email.

I understand that as a Genesis Academy student, I may not participate in any clubs, on-campus activities, sports teams, or any other programs associated with Prescott High School.

I understand that I must submit a request via email to the Director of Genesis Academy (Ms. Tymchak- christina.tymchak@prescottschools.com) to attend any PHS school dances, so that she can request permission from PHS Administration on my behalf. I understand that I must submit this request to attend no later than two weeks prior to the dance. I understand that if I am approved to attend the dance, I will have a special pass and must present that pass to enter the dance. I understand that I cannot invite anyone to the dance that is not a PHS or Genesis Academy student. I understand that if I am unable to follow the conduct expectations of the event, I will not be able to remain at the event.

I understand that when I am logged into the Schools PLP platform, my time spent on the platform and my completion of assignments is being tracked for attendance purposes.

I understand that I must meet the requirements of adequate progress as outlined in Arizona law regarding Dropout Recovery Programs (<https://www.azleg.gov/ars/15/00901-06.htm>).

- Genesis Academy requires the completion of a minimum of twelve courses or six credit hours in a twelve month period (this includes the summer months of June and July). This is equal to completing one class per month OR roughly 20 hours of sustained coursework a week.
- If a lack of adequate progress is determined by the Genesis Academy staff, the student may be locked out and unable to log onto their classes until the student emails Ms. Tymchak- christina.tymchak@prescottschools.com to determine a plan for improved success. If students do not make adequate progress for more than three months, they may be withdrawn from Genesis Academy.
- The ultimate goal is to make more than adequate progress, to complete courses consistently, and to earn the remaining credits in order to graduate.

I understand that, in accordance with Arizona law regarding Dropout Recovery Programs, I must complete at least one class per month OR 20 hours of work in the PLP platform every week of the year that I am enrolled in Genesis Academy.

I understand that Genesis Academy is a self-directed academic process. A serious commitment on my part is necessary for success, and to progress toward graduation.

I understand that I must regularly check my Prescott Unified School District email address, as that is how Genesis Academy staff will communicate with me.

I understand that I am not permitted on the Prescott High School campus during a regular school day, unless I have a scheduled appointment. I understand that failure to comply with this policy may result in being charged with trespassing and subject to prosecution.

I understand that I must meet ALL graduation requirements for Prescott High School as stated in the Prescott High School handbook ([LINK](#)).

Work completion deadlines in Genesis Academy:

- I understand that Genesis Academy students who want to participate in the Prescott High School Commencement Ceremony must complete ALL graduation requirements at least two weeks prior to the Commencement Ceremony date that they want to participate in.
- If I choose not to participate in the Prescott High School Commencement Ceremony, there are no work submission deadlines in Genesis Academy, except for my 22nd birthday. I understand that I have until my 22nd birthday to complete all my graduation requirements. Students are no longer eligible for high school services once they reach the age of 22 according to state law.

I understand that as a Genesis Academy student, I must take ALL standardized tests required by the state of Arizona, and that the state of Arizona determines eligibility. These tests must be taken in-person in Prescott, AZ as follows:

9th grade students:

- ACT Aspire Test

11th grade students:

- ACT Test
- AZSCI tests

Testing dates and specific testing locations in Prescott, AZ are provided to students in advance. Failure to attend state testing will result in your Schools PLP Account being locked until you have come in-person to complete the tests. If the tests are not completed within the provided testing time windows, the student's enrollment status may be reviewed.

If I am part of the Special Education Program, I understand that I am required to attend my IEP meeting, and to meet with our Genesis Special Education Instructor (during Genesis hours of operation) for the amount of time specified in my IEP. An IEP addendum will be required for this to be changed.
