1. Approve the minutes from February 8, 2024 Motion to approve: Brook Brandt Seconded the Motion: Alyse Woodbury All voted to approve
2. Review current Trustland budget
 - Purchase of iPads (Trustlands) and Apple TV's (school funds)
 - Are we on track to spend under 10% of our budget.

The spending of the \$4500 on technology is not reflected on the budget sheet yet, but it has been spent. It was used for teacher ipads. They will be used by teachers so they can instruct as they move around the room, and what they write on the ipad will be seen on the screen. All that's left to be spent are para-pro salaries. We will get way below 10% of our budget.
3. School Musical Report Went great. It was featured in the Herald Journal, and the district website. Valerie spoke about it.
4. Netsmartz report-assembly held on Feb. 20. As a teacher Alyse spoke about this. It went great. Lot's of good information. It was done in two groups, K-2 and 3-6. It was well worth the spending from Trustlands. It is in our plan again to do.
5. Review Parent Conferences Went well. We were able to visit with most parents.
6. Kindergarten Registration update So far, we have 30 students registered. We hope we can get close to 65. We had 29 at this time last year, and ended up with 65. Decreasing kindergarten enrollment is affecting our overall enrollment. We will likely be down at least 1 teacher next year due to decreasing enrollment.
7. Kids Empowered this week/Cowboy Rendezvous presenters during Music Classes this week. Both have gone great. We talked about how Kids Empowered works, that parents have to opt kids into it. It is the old "Good Touch, Bad Touch" program. We've done it for a long time and parent generally are very comfortable with it. Very few kids are opt'd out, but there are a few.

8. Parental Input forms are now in the office and will be throughout the month of March. They continue to be available in the office. It was discussed how it works, and that the state requires is to have some procedure for parents to give input. This is the instrument we use for this statute, and have actually used it before it became a state requirement.
9. 6th Grade South Cache Registration/Tour happened on March 12.
It went well and 6th grade students are on their way to becoming registered.
10. Report on Hats Off awards
Parents have helped us out with this and we have 5 teachers that were nominated, with some of these teachers receiving multiple nominations. There will be 12 receipts across the district, so we'll hope for the best.
11. Discuss/Possibly Approve Trustland Plan for 2024-2025. Refer to draft form of plan from last month.
No one proposed changes to the draft we reviewed last month. Glen reviewed the plan, discussing what each expenditure goes toward. Alyse motioned to approve the plan. Brooke seconded the motion. Approved by Brook Brandt, Valerie Plowman, Alyse Woodbury, Glen Harris, and by Kiesha Baldwin and Jonathan Marchant with absentee votes. No votes to not approve.
12. Review Open Seats for the community council for next year.
Brook's term is up, but she would like to serve for another term. Valerie will resign her seat since he won't have a child at Wellsville next year. Her youngest is headed to middle school. At the end of April we will announce that there are two open position with one person who would like to serve another term. If we have more people then positions we will have an election in the August.
