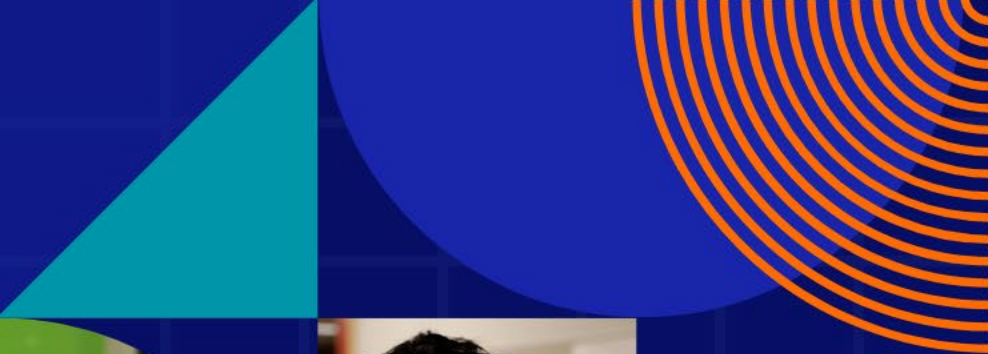

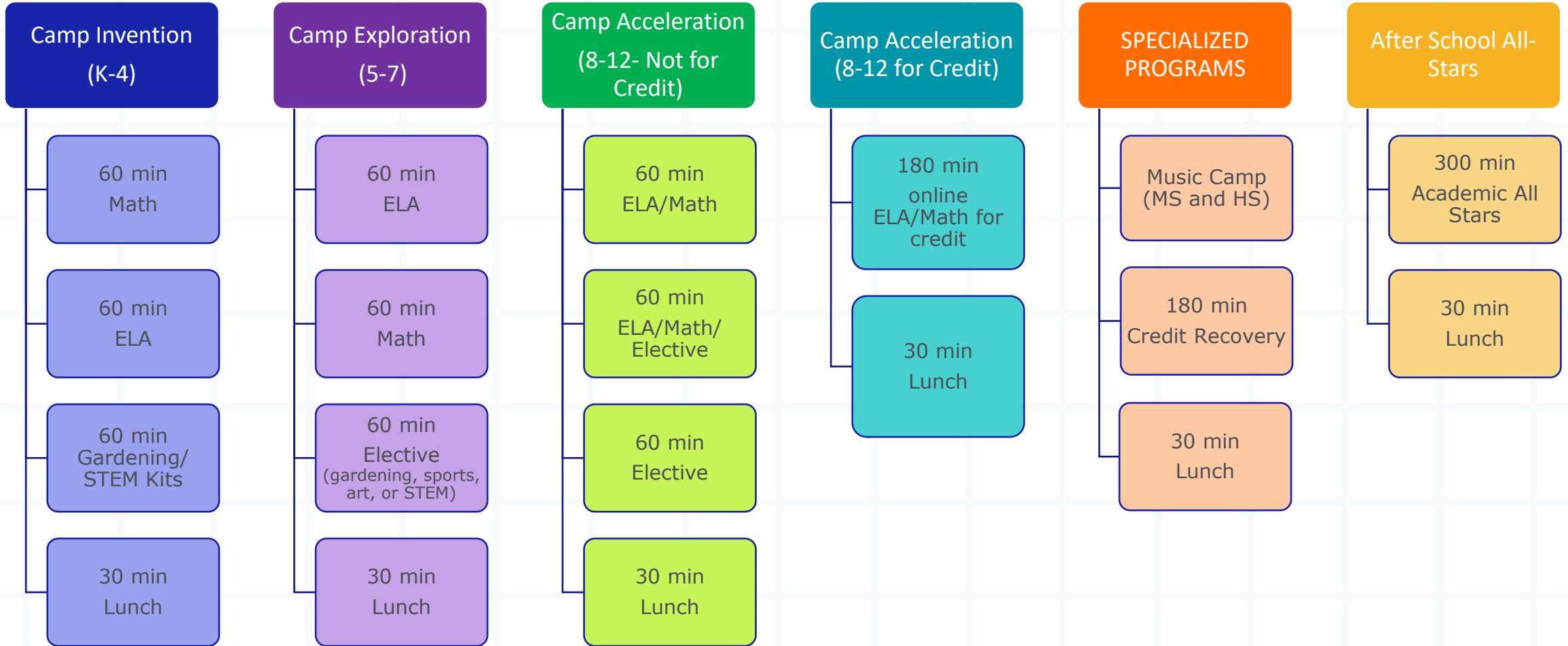

We've offered a variety of programs to school-selected scholars for all grade levels, including Academic Language Academy, Boys and Girls Club, Camp Acceleration, and more.



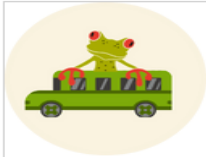
Online Learning Resources
