Starting Date for Filing: **December 16, 2024**  
Ending Date for Filing: **February 14, 2025**

#### **Requirements to hold office:**


- Be a qualified (registered) voter [Education Code 11.061 (b)]
- Take the official oath of office [Education Code 11.061 (a)]
- Serve without compensation [Education Code 11.061 (d)]
- Have been a continuous resident of the state for twelve months and a resident of the District for six months prior to the last date a candidate may file to be listed on the ballot. [Election Code 141.001 (a) (5)]

#### **Application Procedures:**

- Any individual who meets the above requirements may pick up a filing packet from the Mathis ISD Superintendent's Office, 410 East San Patricio Ave, Mathis, Texas 78368
- Applications must be signed, notarized, and state the place for which the applicant is a candidate (ex. Place 1, Place 2 ...) the term of office for School Trustees is four years.
- All applications filed are public records and open to inspection upon request.
- Completed applications must be filed at Mathis ISD Administration Office.
