Applicant will utilize their Mark Kilroy Foundation scholarship for educational purposes, (i.e. tuition and fees required for enrollment or attendance at the educational institution, and fees, books, supplies and required equipment for courses at the educational institution) as a candidate for a degree at an education institution that maintains regular faculty and curriculum and normally has a regularly enrolled body of students in attendance at the place where it carries on its educational activities. The Mark Kilroy Foundation has the sole discretion whether scholarship payments will be made directly to students or their educational institutions; and any changes in scholarship payment amounts.

The Mark Kilroy Foundation reserves the right to end current and cancel future scholarship payments when the following happens:

1) Annual charitable funding limitations arise, 2) Applicant does not submit complete transcript and registration records for scholarship payment, 3) Applicant does not timely submit a request for scholarship payment for one or more semesters and/or does not respond to contact attempts made by the Mark Kilroy Foundation, 4) Applicant attends an out of state school and 5) Applicant fails to maintain a grade point average (GPA) for Spring or Fall semesters of 2.5/4.0 and complete 12 or more semester hours (full-time student) or schedule determined and approved by the Mark Kilroy Foundation.

Applicants perpetually authorize the use of their name, award photographs taken and information submitted to the foundation without payment or future compensation for website, social media, (i.e. Facebook, X, etc.) and verbal and written discussion purposes by the Mark Kilroy Foundation and its representatives.

Applicant authorizes their Texas accredited colleges, educational centers, trade schools, technical schools, vocational schools, and the U.S. Department of Education to release their information to the Mark Kilroy Foundation to verify the accuracy of an applicant's scholarship information submitted to the Mark Kilroy Foundation and to verify information for future scholarship payments. If required, this document verification includes the scholarship applicant's college registrations, trade or technical school registrations, college transcripts, trade or technical school transcripts and certifications, scholarships including athletic awards and endorsements, financial aid awards, (i.e. FAFSA, state and other grant programs), student loan awards and other information requiring verification of information that was submitted on your scholarship application and requests for scholarship payments from the Mark Kilroy Foundation.

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION AND ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

We encourage **ALL** Santa Fe, Alvin, Angleton High School, Ball, Brazosport, Brazoswood, Columbia, Danbury, Dickinson, Friendswood, Hitchcock, La Marque, Manvel, Sweeny and Texas City High School seniors, graduates or TXCHSEs , i.e. GEDs to apply.

We encourage **ALL** Salvation Army Houston Adult Rehabilitation Center (ARC) graduates with U.S. high school diplomas, GEDs or those not finishing to apply.

We have **no age limitation** if you meet our eligibility requirements to apply but you **must attend a Texas** accredited college or trade school.

Each scholarship totaling \$4,000 will be paid over four years to the student or directly to their educational provider based on academic performance and completed semester hours; or amounts and duration determined by the Mark Kilroy Foundation. Be sure to indicate if you earned dual credit, received your associate's college degree while in high school, and your trade or technical school requirements.

For awarded scholarships, the Mark Kilroy Foundation will review your application, estimated yearly expenses and other records to determine if your scholarship warrants a payment increase based on a shorter anticipated completion of a college degree or trade school certificate.

REQUIRED ANTI-DRUG ESSAY

We are very interested in your thoughts about drug use among youth. As a part of your scholarship application, please provide careful consideration for this problem. Write your thoughts and opinions about preventing students in your school or others you know or knew from trying or using illegal drugs. For those you know at school or other places that use any illegal drugs, consider why and how they started using.
