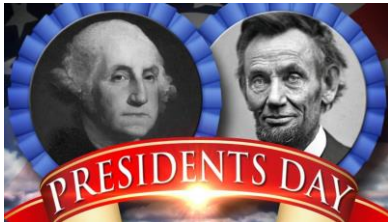

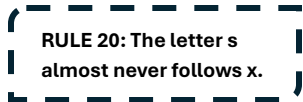

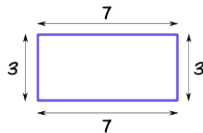
Spelling: Our next test, on Thursday, 2/13, will cover List 17 and Rule 20.
