CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

Exciting School Renovations and Upgrades

Many changes have taken place over the summer!

With the passage of our November 2022 bond levy, we have successfully made progress on multiple projects this summer. While there is still work to be done, we will continue to work closely with the construction companies to ensure that we have the quality materials and craftsmanship our students deserve.

Arrowhead, Fort Island, and Herberich Primary schools will be equipped with new restrooms. The blue and gold tiles in each restroom are looking amazing!

Improved parking lots and traffic flow have been designed for each of the five buildings. Due to the number of construction vehicles this summer, the parking lot work will be completed during the summer of '25.

At Copley-Fairlawn Middle School, students will enjoy a new, inviting cafeteria with upgraded tables and chairs. They will also enjoy school lunches prepared in a new kitchen. Nearly all the restrooms throughout the building have been renovated to include all new fixtures and a cool gray-beige color palette. Locker

rooms will share this same color palette when they are completed this fall.

The middle school track and field are coming along with new lights, turf, fencing, and bleachers being installed. The project is scheduled to be completed in mid-September.

Copley High School has been incredibly busy with the renovation in full swing. Due to a delay in getting the necessary permits, we have asked Infinity Construction to prioritize the areas that need to be completed to ensure a safe return of students on August 20th, including restrooms, the cafeteria, and the kitchen.



We ask for your patience as we continue to work with the contractors to complete the renovations in our district.
