All restrooms and locker rooms have been fully renovated, now showcasing a fresh, modern gray-beige color palette. The Middle School track and field complex is near completion and has quickly become a favorite gathering place for school and community teams playing on the new turf and under the lights.

Copley High School has been bustling with ongoing renovations.
