SAT or ACT

Attention Juniors and Seniors:

Deadline Dec 10th

Students are being offered the opportunity to take the SAT or ACT at their high school during the regular school day at no cost in the Spring 2025 semester. The State Department of Education (SCDE) will be paying for one assessment per student this year. However, students must sign up in advance in order to take one of these tests. All students must designate one choice. Below are the options they will get to pick from. Please talk over these options with your student in advance. Please note, that students who have accommodations such as an IEP or 504 those accommodations are subject to approval by SAT or ACT not HCS.

Overview of EOC

The End-of-Course Examination (EOC) is a statewide assessment program that awards units of credit in English/language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies. The EOC encourages instruction in the specific standards for the courses, encourages student achievement, and documents the level of students' mastery of the academic standards. EOC examination scores count 20 percent in the calculation of the student's final grade in gateway courses. Defined gateway courses currently include Algebra 1, Biology 1, English 2, and United States History.
