THE SCHOOL DISTRICT CLERK

Pursuant to Section 2121 of the <u>Education Law</u> of the State of New York, the school district clerk shall, in addition to performing the duties prescribed by law, act as clerk of the Board of Education, and shall: attend all regular and special meetings of the school board; make full and accurate minutes of the proceedings of the school board; give notice of all meetings of the school board; keep all records and official papers pertaining to district meetings and elections; and perform all other such duties as the Board of Education or superintendent of schools may require.
