The Parkland Middle Schools are excited to inform you of the many musical opportunities that are offered to your child. Students may participate in any one or a combination of the following Performing Music ensembles: Band, Chorus, and/or String Orchestra. Parkland School District allows students in performing ensembles to be exempt from General Music.

The Parking Middle Schools operate on as its (6) marking period schedule. Students choosing a Performant Maric will reached us a class claring marking periods two (2) and fire (3).
