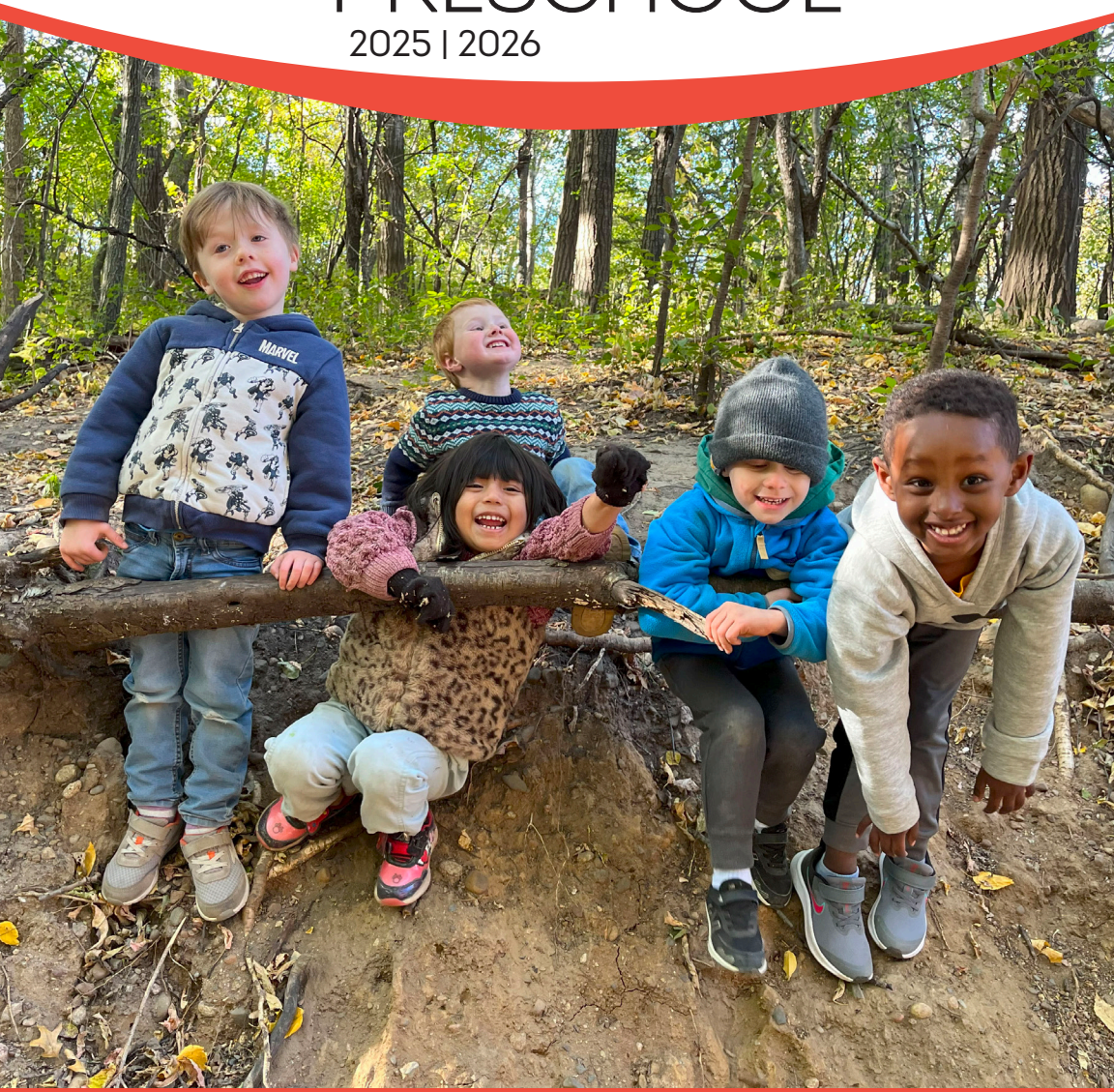

## Application Process

### Apply online at [ce.district196.org/preschool](https://ce.district196.org/preschool)

Applications received by **March 9, 2025** will have priority processing. Those families will be notified via email no later than March 31, 2025 whether their child has been placed in a preschool classroom OR if they have been placed on a waiting list. Due to space limitations, we cannot place all applicants.

Applications received after **March 9, 2025** will be reviewed if space becomes available throughout the 2025-2026 school year (September 2025 to June 2026).

## Connections Preschool

**Connections Preschool** provides high-quality early learning experiences for 3- and 4-year-old children in District 196, facilitated by Minnesota licensed teachers and teaching assistants. We believe early childhood is a remarkable time of social, physical, emotional and cognitive development. Our goal is to support the development of children by nurturing their natural curiosity and eagerness to learn. Our *Connecting to Our World* for 4-year-olds and *Exploring Our World* for 3-year-olds curriculum consists of teacher-facilitated opportunities that allow children to explore the world around them. Children are encouraged to explore, notice, ask and answer questions, make discoveries and learn new concepts and skills through play-based social interactions with their friends and teachers. We understand parents/guardians are a child's first and most influential teachers and hope to partner with you to make this time of early learning a successful experience for you and your child.

- ✓ Children must meet age requirements as of **September 1, 2025** for 3- and 4-year-olds, and **November 1, 2025** for Preschool Discovery.

- ✓ Concurrent enrollment in Connections Preschool and other state and/or district funded programs cannot be accommodated (ex. Head Start or Family School).
- ✓ Connections Preschool is a collaboration with our district's Early Childhood Special Education program.



# Preschool Discovery

## Parent/Guardian and Young Preschooler Experience

### Age Requirement

Children must be 3 years old on or before **November 1, 2025** and not yet 4 years old.

### Location

Dakota Valley Learning Center,  
4679 144th Street West, Apple Valley

### Class Description

Are you looking for a first preschool experience for your child? This class combines an Early Childhood Family Education (ECFE) class with preschool and meets twice per week. An early childhood teacher guides children with preschool experiences that meet their developmental needs and encourages their natural curiosity. Once a week on Mondays, parents/guardians participate in classroom activities and a parent discussion with a licensed parent educator, focused on the joys and challenges of raising a preschooler.



Preschoolers attend both Monday and Wednesday and **parents/guardians attend every Monday with their children.**

**Preschool Discovery Sibling Care** is available only on Mondays for children ages 9 weeks through prekindergarten for families attending Preschool Discovery with another child. Space is limited. Tuition is \$60/month/child. The fee is non-refundable if a child is absent. Scholarships are not available for Preschool Discovery Sibling Care.

# Preschool for 4-Year-Olds: Half Day

Preschool is held September 2025 to June 2026

## Age Requirement

Children must be 4 years old on or before **September 1, 2025** and not yet 5 years old.

## Locations

Classes are offered in collaboration with 17 elementary schools within the district and the Cedar Valley Learning Center.

## Transportation

Parents/guardians are welcome to transport their child to any of the preschool sites in place of busing.

The child's residence or childcare address **must** be in the elementary school attendance area to be eligible for bus transportation. To determine eligibility to receive bus transportation, please visit <http://bit.ly/Schoolboundary>. **Families not eligible for busing must provide transportation to and from preschool.**

- Children are picked up and dropped off at the closest bus stop to their home or childcare.
- Parents/guardians or known adults must be present for a 4-year-old to be picked up and dropped off at the bus stop.
- Children may be riding with elementary-aged students.



## Oak Ridge Nature-Based Preschool

### Class Description

Oak Ridge Elementary School of Leadership, Environmental and Health Sciences is partnering with Connections Preschool to offer a unique option for students to experience preschool in a **primarily outdoor classroom environment** (an indoor classroom will be utilized as needed). In this program children will experience curriculum and skill development all while being immersed in Minnesota's changing seasons and variety of weather. A strong environmental education emphasis, fostering children's connection with the natural world, will be integrated into the daily experience.

# Preschool for 4-Year-Olds: Full Day

## Class Description

Looking for a preschool program plus childcare? We offer full day options on a limited basis in the following schools: Echo Park, Northview, Oak Ridge and Parkview Elementary. In this program, children will experience the Connections Preschool curriculum and skill development facilitated by a licensed early childhood teacher, lead childcare teacher and teaching assistant. In addition, breakfast, lunch and rest time are imbedded throughout their day. This program is implemented in partnership with the Eagan YMCA.

## Childcare

Extended day childcare for an additional fee is available Monday through Friday mornings from 7:30-9:30 a.m. and Friday afternoons from 12:00-3:50 p.m. This time is focused on extended opportunities and social interactions through play and facilitated by the classroom lead childcare teacher.

## Transportation

Parents/guardians must provide transportation to preschool if enrolling in before school childcare.

## Early Childhood Screening

Early Childhood screening is an opportunity for children and their parents/guardians to participate in a FREE health and development screening. State law requires screening for all children entering public kindergarten.

**All 3- and 4-year-old children are required to complete screening within 90 calendar days after the first day of Connections Preschool.** If your child will be 3 or 4 on **September 1, 2025** and has not been screened, please schedule an appointment online at [www.district196.org/screening](http://www.district196.org/screening).

## Immunizations

Children's current immunization record, or a medical/conscientious exemption form, is required and must be provided prior to starting preschool.
