

Cubs' Den Toddler/2s Assistant Teacher

We are looking to hire a qualified caregiver to assist our lead teacher in the toddler/2s room for the 2025-2026 school year. The ideal candidate would provide a positive learning environment rooted in Christian faith for the children of the Wesleyan School faculty. The toddler/2s room consists of no more than 10 children. The desired applicant would have experience teaching in an infant, toddler, or preschool classroom. He or she must have a strong Christian faith, display a friendly demeanor, have a love for children, and strive to create a supportive and encouraging environment for both children and teachers.

This position follows the Wesleyan School calendar and receives holiday and summer breaks, and it begins in August 2025.

Responsibilities:

- Ensure a safe, happy, and stimulating environment for children.
- Support the lead teacher by providing age-appropriate instruction to children between the ages of 18 months – 2 years.
- Assist with communication with parents, as needed.
- Provide basic care for children including but not limited to diaper changing, adhering to a feeding schedule, and potty training.
- Ensure that facilities are safe for children and comply with laws and regulations.
- Support teachers and children in the classroom each day.

Qualifications:

- Associate's or bachelor's degree in a related field preferred but not required.
- Experience working with children required.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
- Organizational, problem-solving, and time-management skills.
