## Food-Related

### Food Fundamentals

- Intro course that exposes students to food science and nutrition principles.
- Prerequisite to ALL other foods courses

### Regional and International Foods

- Exposes students to different cultures, and cuisines within our own country.

### Baking and Pastry Arts

- Expands cooking principles into creative baking includes units on: quick breads, yeast breads, cakes, pies and specialty desserts.

### Foodservice Industry

- Gives a comprehensive look into culinary history, development of different cuisines and expanding on skills introduced in the culinary industry.
- MUST pass all other food-related classes to enroll.
- Must be 11-12 grade to enroll

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## Child-Related

### Child Development 1

- Explores human development from conception to age 3.
- Prerequisite to Child Development 2.

### Child Development 2

- Advanced study of human development of preschool aged children (3-5 years).
- Operation of a preschool teaching lab.

## Human Relations

- Helps students understand functions of families, healthy relationships, healthy lifestyles, goal setting, all things "adulting"
- Must be 11-12 grade to enroll

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## Clothing-Related

### Fashion Design and Construction 1

- Intro course that exposes students to elements and principles of fashion and basic sewing skills.
- Prerequisite to ALL other fashion design and construction classes.

### Fashion Design and Construction 2

- Expands on skills from FD&C1, applying creative construction and personal fitting techniques, as well as fashion history.

### Fashion Design and Construction Studio

- Allows students to demonstrate their knowledge of fashion and garment construction with advanced sewing techniques.
- Must be 10-12 grade to enroll.

### Fashion Design and Merchandising

- Introduces students to a variety of careers related to the fashion industry.
- Topics covered include: function of the fashion industry, marketing terminology, and fashion cycles.
- Must be 11-12 grade to enroll

## Housing & Interior Design

- Combines principles of interior design and information related to securing a living space.
- Focus on creating and design interior spaces, and safety/security.
- Must be 10-12 grade to enroll
