

SDC: STATEWIDE DUAL CREDIT

We offer 2 SDC classes at BHS for Seniors: SDC Criminal Justice II (which is really Criminal Justice 3) SDC Intro to Business

Students will take a CHALLENGE EXAM at the end of the course, and if they score at mastery, some TN Public colleges may award credit.

We offer 18 AP classes at BHS. Advanced Placement, or AP classes, provide college level instruction helping prepare students for the rigorous coursework encountered in college.

Students can earn college credit, skip intro-level courses, or both, at thousands of U.S. colleges and universities.

Each AP class requires a \$105.00 fee for the exam taken in May.

Students wanting to take Honors, SDC, AP and Dual Enrollment courses must complete a contract to request these classes.

Students are **not allowed to drop** Honors, SDC, AP and Dual Enrollment courses after the last day of school (May 22). It is recommended students have a 90 or higher average in the pre-requisite class due to the academic rigor.

Contracts require students to indicate their current Y1 average in the pre-requisite class. This can be found in PowerSchool.
