Application qualifications:

- Manteca Unified School District or Discovery Challenge Academy senior on track for graduation
- Minimum grade point average of 2.5
- Planning to attend a four-year college/university, junior college, or accredited trade/technical school after graduation

Instructions:

The application must include:

- Letter stating intent of studies and career goal
- Completed application form—must be typed OR <u>neatly hand-written</u> in blue or black ink
- Current copy of student's transcript
- One letter of recommendation from a staff member at the student's school
- EFC from FAFSA or copy of parents' or legal guardian's most recent W-2(s)

Process:

- Application is to be completed and submitted to Counseling Center by April 24, 2025.
- Applications will be paper screened by each high school staff to narrow the field to three applicants. Financial need should be considered when screening the applicants.
- The applicants from each school will be interviewed by a panel representing the Women of Woodbridge. **Tentative** dates for interviews are **April 29 and 30**.
- Scholarships will be awarded to the top candidates among the MUSD and Discovery Challenge Academy. There is no guarantee that every school will have a recipient.
- In order to claim their scholarship monies, recipients must submit, <u>by December 1,</u> <u>2025</u> proof of school registration in a four-year college/university, junior college, trade, or technical school program. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of the scholarship.
- The funds will be sent directly to the school's Financial Aid Office.
