The curriculum is based on the International Baccalaureate, PYP, MYP and Diploma Programme and also meets U.S. college preparatory standards. Students take year-long courses in English, Spanish, Math, Science, (Biology, Physics, Chemistry, and Environmental Science), Social Science (History, Psychology, Economics, and Theory of Knowledge), Fine Arts, Computer Science and Physical Education.

About our Credits and Internal Assessment

We provide 120 clock hours of instruction per unit of credit as per the standard of Cognia. High school students take an average of eight courses per semester. A 10-point, unweighted grading scale is used. For comparison with U.S. schools the following scale is appropriate:
